## In Memoriam

It is with deep regret to announce the passing of Legionnaire Leon Howard, 88, passed away at his residence, Tuesday, Sept. 4, 2012. Born Feb. 2, 1924 in Shady, he was a son of the late Oscar and Emma Ricks Howland and was a lifelong resident of Shady. Mr. Howland was a carpenter and was employed by Roy Hoffman Construction, of West Hurley, for many years. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the U.S. Army 508th Parachute Infantry (Red Devils), attached to the 82nd Airborne. He received the Purple Heart, for injuries received in Belgium. He was a member of the American Legion Post 1026, Woodstock, DAV, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and was also a member of A.A.R.P. He was predeceased by two sons, Daniel and Kiefer Howland, several brothers, and sisters. Surviving are his daughter Emma Durlene Baccarelli of Shady; a son, Dean W. Howland of Alaska; and three sisters, Elsie Elliott of Kingston, Lillian Baker of Manchester, Conn., and Mardell Maier of Kingston; a grandson, Christopher Baccarelli of Coxsackie; many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

## RETURN THE F.A.V.O.R.

(FIND & ASSIST VETS OF RECORD)

Ulster County has joined the ranks of Rockland, Orange, Putnam and others in offering veterans a discount purchasing program. The return the F.A.V.O.R. (Find & Assist Veterans of Record) discount program will give honorably discharged veterans the opportunity to apply for a County-issued I.D. card which will allow them to obtain discounts on goods and services at local participating businesses. Veterans who wish to apply for this program should visit the Veterans' Service Agency located at 308 Flatbush Avenue in Kingston. They will need to present their DD-214 discharge papers in order to qualify. Once the proper documentation has been verified, veterans will go to the County Clerk's Office at 244 Fair Street, Kingston to have their picture taken and receive their discount card.
